PAST SIMPLE
(byl/a jsem, byl/a jsi, byl/a, bylo, byli/y)

I was	We were
You were	You were
He was She was It was	They were

SLOVESO MÍT

(HAVE GOT)

PRESENT SIMPLE
(mám, máš, má, máme, mají, máte)

I have got	We have got
You have got	You have got
He has got She has got It has got	They have got

PAST SIMPLE minulý prostý	PRESENT SIMPLE přítomný prostý
